 - An "Applicant" is a residential Board of Water Supply, City and County of Honolulu account holder receiving potable water services from the Board of Water Supply. a) Rebates are awarded only to an eligible Account Holder. The Account Holder can reassign the rebate payment to another Payee in Step 2. Applicants are ultimately responsible for compliance with these Terms and Conditions.
 - b) "Qualifying Devices" are those water-saving items that are identified in the program materials. For measures listed with ENERGY STAR® or EPA WaterSense® ratings, the brand and model must be LISTED on the ENERGYSTAR.gov or EPA.gov/watersense website. All equipment must be new, meet Program specification
 - requirements and be fully operable prior to rebate payment. Clothes Washer must be ENERGY STAR[®] certified i)
 - (1) Rebate amount: \$75.00 USD. Limit one (1) per Applicant.
 - ii) Rain Barrel - must be at least 45 gallons in size
 - (1) Rebate amount: \$40.00 USD. Limit four (4) per Applicant.
